Teacher's Guide

- Review the steps for converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers before students begin.
- Encourage students to check each answer by converting it back to the other form.
- Provide multiplication and division support for students who need additional practice with basic facts.
- Have students work with a partner to explain the pattern they notice when converting in each direction.
- Challenge early finishers to create three new rows for the table and exchange them with a classmate.
- Extend the activity by asking students to order all the mixed numbers from least to greatest.
