Teacher's Guide

- Review the conversion steps: multiply the whole number by the denominator, add the numerator, then keep the same denominator.
- Encourage students to show their multiplication and addition beside each problem.
- Provide a conversion example or multiplication chart for students who need extra support.
- Have partners compare answers and explain the steps they used to convert each mixed number.
- Challenge students to convert their improper fractions back into mixed numbers to check their work.
- Extend the activity by asking students to write three mixed numbers of their own and exchange them with a classmate for practice.
