In 1776, the American colonies decided to declare independence from Great Britain. The Declaration explained **why** they were separating, describing the unfair taxes and limits on their freedoms. It also stated the **rights** all people should have-life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. Finally, it announced the **result** of these beliefs: the colonies would form a new nation, free from British rule, and able to govern themselves.
