Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Offer word cards for tactile learners to physically sort into labeled groups.
 - Provide definitions or short clues for struggling readers to support comprehension.
 - Challenge advanced learners to justify their sorting decisions in one or two sentences.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Create a "living word wall" where students tape their sorted terms under category posters.
 - Use role-play: assign students roles as workers, inventors, or city dwellers, and have them explain how two of their words connect to daily life during the Industrial Revolution.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to add two new words they learned from class to one of the categories and explain their choice.
 - Encourage students to write a short paragraph describing how **technology**, **labor**, and **society** were all connected during industrialization.
