Correct chronological order:

- 1. Telephone 1876
- 2. Light Bulb 1879
- 3. Assembly Line 1913

Expected concepts in student responses:

- Telephone: improved communication and business transactions; connected cities and families
- **Light Bulb**: longer work hours; improved productivity; safer lighting in factories and homes
- Assembly Line: rise of mass production; cheaper goods; growth of consumer culture; repetitive factory work

Reflection answers will vary - acceptable if supported with reasoning (e.g., "the light bulb allowed factories to work longer hours, transforming the economy").

Teacher's Guide

- Introduce inventions through short videos or images
- Encourage students to share personal comparisons: "How would life be harder without phones?"

Differentiation

- Provide sentence frames: "This invention changed life because..."
- Offer vocabulary supports: communication, production, electricity, innovation
- Allow students to complete verbally before writing

Extensions

- Students choose **one more** invention (e.g., typewriter, airplane, skyscraper steel) and add it to the timeline
- Connect to modern-day technologies (smartphones, factory robotics)
- Research a famous innovator and present a mini-biography
