## Intensive Connections Answer Key

1. The president **herself** announced the results of the election. → **D**
2. I wrote this essay **myself** without asking for help. → **A**
3. The children **themselves** built the treehouse in the backyard. → **G**
4. The dog opened the door all by **itself**. → **E**
5. The teacher **herself** graded all the tests in one day. → **D**
6. You will have to finish the project **yourself** if no one helps. → **F**
7. He repaired the old car engine **himself** over the weekend. → **C**
8. We cleaned the entire playground **ourselves** after the event. → **B**

### Teacher Notes / Guide

- Emphasize to students that intensive pronouns are used for **emphasis**, not necessity.
- If students are unsure, remind them that removing the pronoun leaves the sentence still correct, e.g., *"I wrote this essay myself"* → *"I wrote this essay."*
- To extend the activity, have students create **two original sentences** where they correctly match and use different intensive pronouns.
