Irregular Adventures Answer Key

Sample Answer Key (Possible Student Paragraph)

Yesterday, I **went** into the forest and **found** a cave hidden behind tall trees. Inside, I **saw** shining stones on the ground and quickly **took** one to examine it. Suddenly, a group of **children came** running past me, laughing as they pointed at the treasure. I **gave** the stone back to the cave and ran outside. It was the most exciting adventure I had ever experienced!

Irregular forms used correctly: went, found, saw, took, children, came, gave, ran

Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Students practice applying irregular forms **independently** in a creative context, showing they can move beyond recognition into actual usage.
- **Assessment Tip:** Check that students use at least **five different irregular forms** accurately (not repeated forms only).
- **Differentiation:**
 - Beginners may underline irregulars from the word bank before writing.
 - Advanced students can be challenged to use **all 10 verbs** plus at least **2 irregular plural nouns** in their mini-story.
- **Extension Activity:** Have students swap stories with a partner and highlight each other's irregular forms.
