Part A: Core Training

- begin → began → begun

Part B: Obstacle Course

- fly → flew → flown
- go → went → gone

- sing → sang → sung

Part C: Final Challenge

- swim → swam → swum
- take → took → taken
- throw → threw → thrown
- write → wrote → written
- see → saw → seen

Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Students practice transforming irregular verbs into their **past tense** and **past participle** forms.
- **Common Pitfall:** Learners often confuse past tense with past participle (e.g., “went” vs. “gone”). Encourage them to use both forms in sample sentences to reinforce meaning.
- **Extension Activity:** Have students write one sentence in **simple past** and one in **present perfect** using each verb to show the difference.
- **Differentiation Tip:** Offer a smaller set of verbs for beginners, or add advanced verbs like *arise*, *shake*, *shrink*, *forbid* for stronger students.
