

## Italy's Economic Forces Answer Key

1. They are close to major European trade routes and have skilled workers, making it easier to ship products and develop advanced goods.
2. It provides mild winters, dry summers, and lots of sunlight, which help crops like grapes, olives, and citrus fruit grow.
3. Grapes, olives, wheat, and citrus fruits.
4. Because Italy has coastlines, historic cities, artistic heritage, mountains, and sunny regions that attract visitors.
5. Northern regions favor manufacturing and fashion due to trade access, while central and southern regions support food production and tourism because of climate and natural features.
6. Answers will vary but should cite geographic features such as mountains, climate, coastlines, or trade routes.
