Definitions (acceptable student answers may vary in wording):

- 1. A document giving permission to create a colony
- 2. A settlement ruled by another country
- 3. Economic system where colonies support the mother country
- 4. A plant grown and sold for profit
- 5. Time when many colonists starved or struggled to get food
- 6. Native American alliance near Jamestown

Quick Connect: Student should mention a correct role, such as tobacco making money, or the Starving Time causing risk, etc., with 2-3 clear sentences.

Teacher's Guide

- Preview vocabulary before reading about Jamestown
- Highlight the clue words inside each sentence
- Encourage complete sentence responses

Differentiation Options:

- Allow drawing simple symbols next to each term for visual memory
- Provide a sentence frame: "This word is important to Jamestown because..."
- Read sentences aloud to support developing readers

Engagement Ideas:

- Word wall featuring Jamestown vocabulary and student-written definitions
- Partner activity: students quiz one another on terms
- Quick skit: groups act out one vocabulary word and classmates guess the term

Extensions:

- Add more Jamestown vocabulary: fort, cash crop, indentured servant, House of Burgesses
- Short research assignment where each student teaches one word to the class
