Think Deeper: Student should identify a correct pair and explain how it helped Jamestown (such as providing food, making money, or creating safety)

Teacher's Guide

- Review what a "problem" and "solution" look like in history
- Allow discussion before writing deeper explanation
- Encourage students to point to clues in each sentence

Differentiation:

- Allow students to complete matching in pairs
- Challenge higher-level learners to add one more problem and solution from class notes

Engagement Ideas:

- Quick role-play where students act as "Jamestown Advisors" giving solutions
- Create a "Colony Problem-Solvers" poster to display class answers
- Allow students to sort cards on a board before writing

Extension Activities:

- Connect to earlier Jamestown learning: geography, primary sources, archaeology
- Students write a short news headline from the time celebrating one successful solution
