## Picture Maker Answer Key

Answers will vary. Drawings should show:

- sun: circle with rays or a bright sky
- dog: a four-legged animal with ears and a tail
- rain: raindrops falling from clouds
- apple: round fruit with a stem
- car: a vehicle with wheels
- tree: trunk with branches and leaves
- hat: something worn on the head
- fish: an animal with fins and a tail

### Teacher's Guide

- **Using this worksheet**
  - Say each word slowly and clearly, then have students repeat it before drawing.
  - Discuss what each word means and ask guiding questions such as "What do you see when it rains?"
- **Engagement ideas**
  - Turn it into a class art walk where students share their drawings and classmates guess the word.
  - Use color prompts like "Add one more detail to show more meaning" to deepen understanding.
- **Extension ideas**
  - Use the drawings for matching activities later in the week, pairing pictures with printed words.
  - Invite students to draw another example of the same word but in a different setting.
