Teacher's Guide

- **Using this worksheet**
 - Read the **Word Bank** aloud first and have students repeat each word.
 - Encourage students to point to each word in the bank as they test it in the sentence.
- **Differentiation tips**
 - For emerging readers, pair each bank word with a small picture card on the board.
 - Challenge advanced students to write the chosen word neatly on the blank line instead of just pointing or saying it.
- **Engagement ideas**
 - Turn it into a mini drama: after filling in a sentence, have students act it out, such as pretending to ride a **swing** or dig in **sand**.
 - Use call-and-response: you read the sentence and students shout the missing word together.
- **Extension ideas**
 - Ask students to make up one new sentence on the back using any word from the bank.
 - Collect finished pages and read the tiny park story aloud to the class, emphasizing the vocabulary words.
