BIG:

- elephant
- house
- bus
- whale

SMALL:

- ant
- pencil
- seed
- button

Students should place each word in the column that matches its usual size in real life.

Teacher's Guide

- **Using this worksheet**
 - Read the list of words aloud and have students repeat each one to build vocabulary and pronunciation.
 - Talk briefly about what each thing looks like in real life to anchor meaning before sorting.
 - Model one example on the board, such as writing **elephant** under **BIG**, then let students complete the chart.
 - Encourage children to say, "I think it is big," or "I think it is small," as they place each word.
- **Differentiation tips**
 - Provide simple picture cards for each word so students can see the object before deciding on big or small.
 - Challenge advanced students to add one more **big** and one more **small** word of their own at the bottom of each column.
