### Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** Builds vocabulary, word association, and comprehension of job-related terms connected to the Labor Day theme.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - *Grades 3-4:* Read each job and description aloud together before matching. Use pictures of workers to support understanding.
  - *Grade 5:* Have students explain why each tool or description matches the job to deepen reasoning skills.
  - *Upper Grades (Extension):* Add new careers (like software developer or nurse) and have students write their own matching clues.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Create a classroom "Career Wall" with photos or drawings of different jobs.
  - Play a "Who Am I?" guessing game where students describe a job without saying its name.
- **Extension Ideas:**
  - Students can interview a family member about their job and list the tools they use.
  - Encourage creative writing: "If I could have any job, I would be a..." paragraph to connect to the Labor Day theme.
