### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:** Students locate rhyming word pairs with **long vowel** sounds inside simple sentences.
- **Differentiation:**
  - Support: Read each sentence aloud first. Have students clap the rhyming pair (cake, lake) before highlighting.
  - Challenge: Students underline the long vowel spelling pattern in each highlighted word (like a\_e, oa, ee, i\_e).
- **Engagement:** Let students use two different highlighter colors: one color for the first rhyming word, a second color for its rhyming partner.
- **Extension:** Students choose any two sentences and write a new sentence using the same rhyme family (example: -ake, -oat).
