Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:** Students identify rhyming pairs with **long vowel** sounds in complete sentences, building accuracy and reading fluency.
- **Differentiation:**
 - Support: Read each sentence aloud first. Have students point to the two rhyming words before underlining.
 - Challenge: Students label the rhyme pattern (example: ight, ate, ake) above the underlined words.
- **Engagement:** Let students act like detectives and "prove it" by reading the rhyming pair aloud twice, once slowly and once at normal speed.
- **Extension:** Students choose two sentences and rewrite each one with a different rhyming pair that keeps the same meaning.
