Teacher's Guide

- **Quick teach:** Remind students that rhyming words have the same ending sound; the **long vowel** usually "says its name" in words like cake and kite.
- **Differentiation:**
 - Support: Read each line aloud and have students repeat the first word before choosing. Cover the two wrong choices, then reveal them one at a time.
 - Challenge: Ask students to underline the letters that make the long vowel pattern (like a_e, i_e, oa, ee).
- **Engagement:** Let students use quiet "robot voices" to stretch sounds, then say the two best choices out loud to check the rhyme.
- **Extension:** Have students pick any three items and write one more rhyming long vowel word for each (example: cake, lake, make).
