### Teacher's Guide

**Purpose:** This worksheet develops **vocabulary comprehension**, **context clues**, and **cultural awareness** through meaningful phrases used in **Lunar New Year greetings**.

### Quick Tips for Teachers:

- **Warm-Up:** Ask students if they've ever received or seen a Lunar New Year greeting card. Discuss what kinds of wishes people share during this holiday.
- **Differentiation:**
  - For **Grades 3-4:** Read each phrase aloud and guide students to choose the word that makes the most sense.
  - For **Grades 5-6:** Encourage students to explain why their chosen word fits the message of the greeting.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Have students design their own "lucky red envelope" and write one of the completed phrases inside.
  - Teach a few short greetings in Mandarin or Cantonese (e.g., *Gong Xi Fa Cai* means "Wishing you prosperity").
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Challenge students to create a brand-new fortune phrase using three words from the word bank.
  - Integrate art by having students decorate their phrases with symbols like dragons, coins, or lanterns.
