Zodiac Personalities Answer Key

Sample Sorting:

- **Bravery & Confidence:** Tiger, Dragon, Horse
- **Wisdom & Intelligence:** Rat, Snake, Monkey
- **Kindness & Compassion:** Rabbit, Goat, Pig
- **Loyalty & Honesty:** Ox, Rooster, Dog

Sample short response: If someone is born in the Year of the Dog, they might be loyal to their friends and always stand up for what's right. Their honesty could help them earn others' trust.

Teacher's Guide

Purpose: This worksheet builds **categorization**, **reading comprehension**, and **cultural literacy** by exploring the symbolism of zodiac animals in the Lunar New Year tradition.

Quick Tips for Teachers:

- **Introduce Background:** Briefly explain that each year in the Lunar calendar is linked to an animal with special traits that influence personality and luck.
- **Differentiation:**
 - For **Grades 4-5**, simplify by focusing only on personality traits.
 - For **Grades 6-8**, include year ranges and encourage deeper analysis of patterns or personality contrasts.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students find their own zodiac sign and discuss whether the traits fit them.
 - Use role-play or character sketch activities for each animal's personality.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Create a class "Zodiac Trait Wall" where students post drawings or written reflections for each sign.
 - Integrate math by having students calculate which zodiac year they were born in and which one will come next.
