

Teamwork Respect Answer Key

Sample Responses:

1. Listening to each other, waiting turns to speak, and giving compliments like "Good idea."
2. Interrupting, rolling eyes, and ignoring other people's ideas.
3. They started showing respect and included everyone's opinions.
4. Their teamwork improved, and they finished early while enjoying the project.
5. It helps everyone feel valued and makes cooperation easier.

Teacher's Guide:

- **Differentiation Tips:** Read the passage aloud with pauses to highlight polite and impolite behaviors. Provide a list of manners words (respect, patience, listening, kind tone) to support comprehension.
- **Engagement Ideas:** Ask students to underline or highlight polite actions in one color and impolite ones in another. Discuss how each behavior made others feel.
- **Extension Activities:** Have students write their own short "Politeness in Action" story about a time when manners helped them work better in a team. Encourage reflection journals where they track one polite behavior they practice each day.
