Discussion Points Before or After

- Why does the Supreme Court need independence from politics?
- How would government power look without judicial review?
- Does the Court protect or threaten democracy? Support reasoning.

Differentiation Strategies

- Support: Read questions aloud and underline key vocabulary together
- Challenge: Require students to justify two of their answers in writing
- English Learners: Provide a short vocabulary preview (commission, unconstitutional, precedent)

Engagement Ideas

- Partner explanation: Students explain their answer choice to a partner
- Quick debate: Choose a question tied to power and argue both sides

Extension Opportunities

- Students find one modern case showing judicial review in action
