

Structure in Documents Answer Key

1. Chronological/Sequence (steps in order to cook)
2. Cause & Effect (cold front causes storms)
3. Description (hotel details and features)
4. Compare & Contrast (two laptops compared)
5. Problem & Solution (litter problem with suggested fixes)

Teacher Notes:

- Highlight that real-life texts often **blend structures**, but one is usually dominant.
- Encourage students to explain *why* they matched each — not just guess.
- For differentiation:
 - **Struggling learners** can use a word bank of signal words.
 - **Advanced learners** can brainstorm additional real-life documents for each structure.
- Extension: bring in authentic documents (menus, ads, weather apps, manuals) for students to sort in small groups.
