Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Build understanding of factual accuracy about the Mayflower Compact and its purpose.
- **Support Strategies:**
 - Pre-teach key vocabulary: Compact, agreement, govern, colony, signers.
 - Model one example and explain why it is true or false using classroom anchor charts or notes.
- **Differentiation Options:**
 - Provide paired reading so students discuss their reasoning with a partner.
 - Offer sentence starters for developing students: "This is true because..."
 - Encourage advanced learners to write one additional true statement and one false one with corrections.
- **Engagement Idea:** Have students vote on each item as a class to show democracy in action.
- **Extension Activity:** Connect to modern civic agreements by discussing school codes of conduct or local community rules.
