- 1. Unity: Pilgrims agreed to stay together and help one another as a community.
- 2. Faith: They believed their actions honored God and followed their religious beliefs.
- 3. Governance: They created fair laws and chose leaders to guide the colony.

## Teacher's Guide

• **Skill Focus**: Summarizing historical information into clear, topic-focused sentences.

### Instructional Ideas:

- Model with a short "think-aloud" showing how to pull main ideas from previous lessons or anchor charts.
- Encourage strong verbs and clear subject-verb structure.

#### Differentiation:

- Offer sentence starters for emerging writers: "The Pilgrims promised to..."
- Challenge advanced learners to combine all three ideas into one strong paragraph after completing the activity.

## Engagement Strategies:

- Allow students to share at least one of their sentences with a partner for peer feedback.
- Create a class "Compact Board" where selected sentences are posted as community rules.
- **Extension:** Students compare the Pilgrims' promises with rules or agreements used in their own school or community today.
