#### Teacher's Guide

 Objective: Strengthen persuasive writing and historical reasoning about the Mayflower Compact's role in early self-government.

### • Pre-Debate Prep:

- Review key challenges the Pilgrims faced upon arrival
- Brainstorm potential arguments for both sides as a class

### • Differentiation:

- Provide sentence frames for emerging writers: "I believe the Pilgrims needed..."
- Allow oral debates or small-group discussions before writing
- Encourage advanced learners to reference principles of democracy

## • Engagement:

- Hold a structured mini-debate where pairs present their arguments
- Let students vote on the most convincing case (not which side wins historically)

#### Extension:

- Compare this early agreement with later U.S. documents like the Articles of Confederation or the Constitution to trace the development of self-government.
