Expected Key Elements in Student Responses:

Engagement Ideas:

- Host a "**Remembrance Speech Showcase**" where students present their speeches aloud or record them.
- Play short clips of real Memorial Day speeches (e.g., by presidents or veterans) to inspire tone and structure.
- Use background music or visual slideshows during presentations to build emotional connection.

Extension Ideas:

- Create a class anthology titled "*Our Voices of Remembrance*."
- Encourage students to research a local memorial or veteran and dedicate their speech to that person.
