Teacher's Guide

- Provide simple definitions of human and physical geography for reference.
- For students who need more support, offer a few guided examples before independent work.
- Challenge advanced learners to add two new items to each category.

Engagement Ideas

- Show photos of the Sierra Madre, Maya ruins, and coral reefs to spark conversation.
- Ask students to sort themselves into two classroom corners labeled Human and Physical based on quick example items the teacher calls out.
- Use a brief warm-up: Which features do people create and which features are shaped by nature?
