Teacher's Guide

- Read the clues aloud once for all students, then have them work independently.
- Encourage students to underline **key words** in each clue such as long strip, flat area, tall mountain ranges.
- Allow students to check their matches with a partner before reviewing as a class.

Differentiation Tips

- Provide a simple vocabulary list with words like peninsula, ranges, and surrounded.
- Show a labeled map for students who need visual support.
- Challenge advanced learners to write their own landform clues for a quick class game.

Engagement Ideas

- Display photos of each landform for students to observe features.
- Create a short warm-up discussion about landforms students have visited or learned about.
- Ask students which landform they would most like to explore and why.

Extension Activities

- Use the worksheet as part of a larger lesson comparing North American landforms.
- Invite students to research one additional Mexican landform and share one fact with the class.
