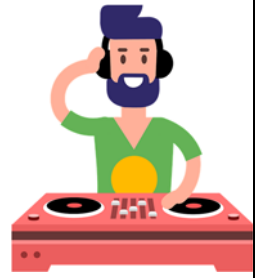

## College & Career Copilot

You probably get asked all the time, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" - and maybe you don't have a clue yet. That's okay. Today, you're going to team up with Microsoft Copilot to explore careers that actually *fit you* - your interests, your strengths, and maybe even your hobbies. The goal isn't to pick a job right now; it's to discover possibilities you might not have considered and learn what it takes to get there.



Start by opening Microsoft Copilot and letting it get to know you a bit. Type something like:

"I'm doing a project called College & Career Copilot. Please ask me five questions about my interests, hobbies, and skills so you can help me find three careers that might fit me."

Answer Copilot's questions honestly and in detail - the better your answers, the smarter its suggestions will be. After you've given it enough information, ask:

"Based on my answers, can you list three careers that might match my interests and skills? Include a short explanation for each."

Read Copilot's list carefully. Which jobs catch your attention right away? Which ones surprise you? Copy the three career options below and then start investigating what kind of education, training, or experience each path requires. You can ask Copilot again for help, or do a quick web search to verify.
