	2. Ganymede is larger than the planet Mercury.
	3. Earth's Moon has a permanent dark side that never receives sunlight.
	4. Europa may have a subsurface ocean beneath its icy crust.
	5. Phobos will eventually crash into Mars or break apart.
	6. The Moon's craters were all formed by volcanic eruptions.
	7. Triton orbits Neptune in the opposite direction of the planet's rotation
	8. Enceladus has geysers that shoot water vapor and ice into space.
	9. Callisto is one of Jupiter's moons and has very few impact craters.
	10. The Moon's gravity causes tides on Earth.
	11. Io is the most volcanically active body in the Solar System.
	12. All moons in the Solar System are made entirely of rock.
