- 1 The first confirmed discovery of Jupiter's four largest moons by Galileo Galilei.(1610)
- 2 Triton, Neptune's largest moon, is discovered by William Lassell. (1846)
- 3 The Soviet Luna 2 probe becomes the first human-made object to impact the Moon. (1959)
- 4 NASA's Apollo 11 mission lands the first humans on the Moon. (1969)
- 5 Voyager 1 and Voyager 2 fly past Jupiter and Saturn, discovering active volcanoes on Io. (1979)
- 6 NASA's Galileo spacecraft conducts close flybys of Europa, Callisto, and Ganymede. (1990s)
- 7 The Hubble Space Telescope detects signs of a possible subsurface ocean on Europa. (1990s–early 2000s)
- 8 The Cassini spacecraft observes geysers erupting from Saturn's moon Enceladus. (2005)
- 9 The Japanese spacecraft SELENE (Kaguya) maps the Moon's surface in detail. (2007)
- 10 The New Horizons spacecraft flies by Pluto and Charon. (2015)
