## 1. B - The thunder was loud and powerful.

 The simile compares thunder to a roaring lion, emphasizing strength and noise.

#### 2. **D** - Idiom.

o "Bundle of nerves" is an idiom meaning very anxious or nervous.

### 3. C - Personification.

o The clock is given the human ability to "stare," which it cannot literally do.

## 4. A - The silence was soft and comforting.

 The simile compares silence to a warm coat, showing comfort after the storm.

Encourage students to underline figurative phrases in the passage and ask themselves: *Is this comparing two things (simile/metaphor)? Giving something human qualities (personification)? Or is it a common saying (idiom)?*
