## The Missing Key Answer Key

- 1. "Key" meaning #1 A *legend* or list explaining map symbols.
- 2. "Key" meaning #2 A metal object used to open a lock.
- "Staff" meanings A group of workers and a set of musical lines used for notes.
- 4. "Seal" meanings A *sea animal* and a *closure mark* that keeps something sealed shut.
- 5. Understanding multiple meanings helped Mira realize that the clues referred to different definitions of the same words, leading her to the real key.

## Teacher's Guide

**Skill Focus:** Using **context clues** to interpret **Multiple Meaning Words** and apply critical thinking in reading comprehension.

Grade Range: Ideal for Grades 6-10 (adjustable for 4-12).

## **Differentiation Ideas**

- Support learners: Provide visual aids (e.g., a picture of a key, a staff, and a seal) to connect meanings.
- Challenge learners: Ask them to identify one additional multiple-meaning word in the story or write a new ending with a twist.
- *ELL support:* Translate each key word into students' home language and discuss why English uses the same word for different meanings.

## **Extension Activities**

- Have students write their own short mystery using at least three multiplemeaning words as clues.
- Turn the story into a role-play-assign Detective, Partner, and Suspect roles to build comprehension through drama.
- Create a "Word Evidence Board" where students pin examples of words that can have more than one meaning (from books, ads, or songs).
