Grade Range: Designed for Grades 3-6, easily adaptable for older or younger learners.

Teaching Tips

- Begin with one riddle as a warm-up and model your thought process out loud.
- Encourage students to explain *both meanings* of their answers after solving.
- Read riddles aloud dramatically to add engagement and rhythm to the activity.

Extension Activities

- Host a "Riddle Challenge" where students read their riddles to classmates.
- Turn the worksheet into a group trivia game-students earn points for correct answers and clear explanations.
- Have students illustrate one riddle to show both meanings of the word in a single drawing.
