2. **Watch** - A timepiece / to look at something carefully.
3. **Light** - Brightness / not heavy in weight.
4. **Wave** - To move your hand in greeting / movement of water.
5. **Ring** - Circular jewelry / to make a bell or phone sound.
6. **Seal** - Marine animal / to close something securely.
7. **Fly** - To move through the air / a small insect.
8. **Bat** - A flying mammal / a stick used in baseball.
9. **Park** - Outdoor recreation area / to stop and leave a vehicle.
10. **Pool** - A place to swim / a group of combined resources or money.
