Teacher's Guide

- Use this worksheet to help students identify how **tone** creates mood and guides the reader's feelings.
- Review the meaning of each tone before beginning: excited, gloomy, nervous, peaceful. Provide short examples if needed.
- Encourage students to underline **clue words** in each sentence that hint at tone.
- **Differentiation tips:**
 - Provide a word bank with short definitions for emerging readers.
 - Read sentences aloud for students who benefit from hearing tone in a voice.
- **Engagement ideas:**
 - Let students create one original sentence for each tone and swap with a partner.
 - Turn it into a matching game by printing sentences and tone labels on separate pieces of paper.
- **Extension ideas:**
 - Have students rewrite one sentence to change the tone while keeping the general idea the same.
 - Ask students to explain which words in each sentence made them choose the tone they selected.
