- A strong sense that the narrator is a distinct character, not a neutral voice.

Teacher's Guide

- Encourage students to think of their narrator as a full person with habits, opinions, and quirks.

Differentiation tips:

- Provide a list of tone words for students who need support choosing precise language.
- Allow oral brainstorming before writing for students who organize ideas verbally.

• Engagement ideas:

- Have volunteers read their paragraphs aloud and let the class guess the narrator's personality traits.
