### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Provide a timeline of 19th-century wars for students who need visual sequencing support.
  - Allow struggling students to underline key words (e.g., *Austria, France, Lombardy*) before matching.
  - Challenge advanced learners to explain *why* each outcome advanced unification efforts.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Turn the exercise into a "**War Match Challenge**"-students race to correctly match all four before time runs out.
  - After completing, have students place each war on a classroom timeline labeled "Steps to Unification."
  - Discuss which wars relied more on **diplomacy** and which relied on **military power**.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Assign a short writing prompt: "*Which war do you think had the greatest impact on 19th-century Europe, and why?*"
  - Encourage students to research one of the wars and create a short headline or summary for a 19th-century newspaper.
  - Have students draw a brief "cause and effect chain" explaining how these conflicts led to Italy's or Germany's unity.
