Clues to underline:

- 1. crossed his arms, stared at the floor, didn't say a word
- 2. eyes lit up, leaned forward, clapped her hands, laughed loudly
- 3. rolled his eyes, sighed, shoulders slumped
- 4. eyes widened, ran to help, face looked worried
- 5. smiled softly, gave a small wave, body relaxed
- 6. turned away, avoided eye contact, fidgeted with her pencil
- 7. arms shot into the air, grinned from ear to ear, voice loud and cheerful

Teacher's Guide:

- Model one example on the board by reading aloud and identifying nonverbal clues with students.
- Offer color-coded highlighters (e.g., yellow for face clues, blue for body clues) for visual learners.
