Teacher's Guide

Purpose: This worksheet helps students in grades 4 to 7 recognize key physical features of North America and connect each landform to the correct description.

Instruction Tips

- Preview vocabulary such as plateau, peninsula, and tundra before students begin.
- Encourage students to use a map or atlas to visualize each feature.
- Model one example so students understand how to match correctly.

Engagement Ideas

- Use a large classroom map and have students point to each feature as they match.
- Turn the activity into a partner challenge to see who can match all correctly first.
- Have students create a mini sketch of one feature after completing the worksheet.

Extension Activities

- Students write a short travel guide paragraph describing a journey through two features.
- Connect with science by discussing how landforms affect ecosystems in each region.
- Assign a short research activity where students look up one additional North American landform not listed.
