Teacher's Guide

Purpose: This worksheet helps students in grades 3 to 7 identify major North American landmarks and connect them to short descriptive clues.

Instruction Tips

- Review each landmark with quick visuals or brief background facts.
- Read the descriptions together for younger students before independent work.
- Encourage students to underline clue words such as canyon, waterfall, ancient, or mountain.

Engagement Ideas

- Play a quick guessing game where students try to name a landmark from a one sentence clue.
- Create a classroom display showing each landmark on a map of North America.
- Invite students to vote on which landmark they would most like to visit and explain why.

Extension Activities

- Students create a postcard that features one of the landmarks with a short written message from a pretend visit.
- Assign a short research task where students learn one new fact about each landmark.
- Connect with writing by having students describe a journey to one of the landmarks using sensory details.
