Rhyme Makers Answer Key

Answers will vary. Accept any correct rhyming words. Examples include:

- star: far, car
- fall: ball, tall
- dock: rock, sock
- sheep: deep, keep
- hill: Jill, will
- moon: spoon, tune
- snow: go, show
- spout: out, shout

Teacher's Guide

- **Focus skill:** Generating rhymes by changing the beginning sound while keeping the same ending sound.
- **Differentiation:**
 - Support: Provide one rhyming word orally and have students add one more.
 - Challenge: Ask students to write three rhyming words or use one in a sentence.
- **Engagement tips:**
 - Say the base word together, then stretch the ending sound before writing.
 - Let students share one favorite rhyme with a partner.
- **Extension ideas:**
 - Rhyme chains: Start with one word and see how many rhymes the class can build.
 - Silly swap: Replace the nursery rhyme word with a student-made rhyme and reread the line.
