Silly Rhyme Swap Answer Key

Answers will vary. The new word must rhyme with the bold word and the line must be rewritten correctly. Examples:

1. hill: will, pill
2. fall: ball, tall
3. moon: spoon, tune
4. clock: rock, sock
5. snow: go, show
6. star: far, car
7. sheep: deep, keep
8. spout: out, shout

Teacher's Guide

- **Focus skill:** Identifying a rhyme family and keeping the sentence structure while swapping in a new rhyming word.
- **Differentiation:**
 - Support: Offer two choices for the rhyming swap word; students pick one and rewrite the line.
 - Challenge: Students write two rewritten versions for one line using two different rhymes.
- **Engagement tips:**
 - Read the original line aloud, then read the silly new line with expression.
 - Let students share one rewritten line with a partner and check if it still rhymes.
- **Extension ideas:**
 - Rhyme spotlight: Students underline the rhyming ending in the old word and the new word.
 - Mini book: Students choose two rewritten lines and illustrate them on the back.
