### Teacher's Guide

- **Goal:** Students listen for the ending sounds and choose the word that completes the rhyme.
- **Before students start:** Read two items aloud and emphasize the last word in each line.
- **Differentiation:**
  - Support: Say the two answer choices aloud (for items with similar sound options you can cover the non-matching one first).
  - Challenge: Have students say a new rhyming word for the final word (example: sky, high, my).
- **Engagement ideas:**
  - Use a whisper voice, robot voice, or slow-speech voice to highlight the rhyme ending.
  - Let students tap once on the table when they hear the rhyming word.
- **Extension ideas:**
  - Rhyme swap: Replace the last word with a different rhyming word and keep the rhythm (silly is fine if it rhymes).
  - Small-group game: Students take turns reading an item and classmates point to the correct answer.
