

## Snapshots And Lessons Answer Key

### 1. Text-to-Self

- *Sample Answer:* I once lost my phone and felt very upset, just like Clara was heartbroken over losing her camera.
- *Teacher Note:* Look for honest personal experiences with a comparison to Clara.

### 2. Text-to-World

- *Sample Answer:* This connects to the real-world need to keep track of valuables, like phones, wallets, or cameras, so they don't get lost.
- *Teacher Note:* Accept any practical reasoning linking the story to everyday responsibility.

### 3. Text-to-Text

- *Sample Answer:* In *Toy Story 2*, Woody is lost but eventually found, similar to how Clara's camera was returned. Both stories show relief when something important is recovered.
- *Teacher Note:* Any story comparison works as long as students explain the similarity.

### 4. Text-to-Self

- *Sample Answer:* I can learn not to worry too much about objects and to focus on the memories and experiences instead.
- *Teacher Note:* Look for application of Clara's reflection to students' own lives.

### 5. Text-to-World

- *Sample Answer:* People realize experiences are more valuable because objects can be replaced, but the moments we share and remember cannot.
- *Teacher Note:* Guide students toward recognizing universal human values beyond material things.
