Teacher's Guide

- Remind students that logical sequencing often follows a clear pattern: **prepare, arrive, follow procedures, begin the trip.**
- Provide sentence strips for hands-on learners so they can physically move steps around before numbering them.
- For students needing support, highlight clue words like **pack, check in, board, or seat.**
- Challenge advanced students to create their own travel sequence for a different type of trip, such as a bus ride or boat tour.
- Add a quick verbal warm up where students describe a familiar sequence, such as getting ready for school, to activate prior knowledge.
