### Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Purpose:** This activity strengthens both **fluency** and **comprehension**. Students must read with accuracy and expression, while also showing they understand key details from the text.
- **Implementation Tips:**
  - Model reading the paragraph once with good fluency, then have students echo or chorally read before independent practice.
  - Encourage students to underline or highlight the details that will help them answer the questions.
  - Stress the connection between comprehension and expression: knowing what's important helps them read with meaning.
- **Differentiation:**
  - Provide picture prompts for struggling readers (e.g., suitcase, train, grandmother).
  - Challenge advanced readers by having them summarize the paragraph in one sentence after answering the questions.
- **Extension Idea:** Ask students to imagine what happens next and write a one-sentence continuation, then practice reading both the original paragraph and their addition fluently.
