- 5. 11:00 a.m. I was listening to the teacher.
- 6. 12:00 p.m. I was eating lunch.
- 7. 1:00 p.m. I was reading a book.
- 8. 2:00 p.m. I was playing basketball.
- 9. 3:00 p.m. I was doing homework.
- 10.4:00 p.m. I was helping my mom cook.

Bonus Example: I was reading a book at 1:00 p.m. while my sister was watching TV.

Teacher Notes / Guide

- This worksheet helps students apply the past continuous tense in real-life contexts.
- Timelines encourage students to think **chronologically** and practice using time markers with verbs.
- Accept a wide range of answers; focus on correct use of was/were + verbing rather than exact activities.
- Extension idea: Have students compare timelines in pairs and write 2-3 combined sentences using "while" to show simultaneous actions.
