Example Responses

1. 7:00 a.m. - I **was** waking up.
2. 8:00 a.m. - I **was** eating breakfast.
3. 9:00 a.m. - I **was** walking to school.
4. 10:00 a.m. - I **was** sitting in math class.
5. 11:00 a.m. - I **was** listening to the teacher.
6. 12:00 p.m. - I **was** eating lunch.
7. 1:00 p.m. - I **was** reading a book.
8. 2:00 p.m. - I **was** playing basketball.
9. 3:00 p.m. - I **was** doing homework.
10. 4:00 p.m. - I **was** helping my mom cook.

Bonus Example: I **was** reading a book at 1:00 p.m. while my sister **was** watching TV.

Teacher Notes / Guide

- This worksheet helps students apply the **past continuous tense in real-life contexts**.
- Timelines encourage students to think **chronologically** and practice using time markers with verbs.
- Accept a wide range of answers; focus on correct use of **was/were + verb-ing** rather than exact activities.
- Extension idea: Have students compare timelines in pairs and write 2-3 combined sentences using "while" to show simultaneous actions.
